The Texas Workforce Commission Provider Web Portal gives childcare providers with internet access the ability to view their referrals and the attendance and absence reports for their referred children online. Providers are given temporary User IDs and passwords, which must be changed at the first login. Logging in gives providers access to their referral and attendance information.
